These paintings offer not just a visual experience, but a sensory one—combining the familiarity of kitchen staples with the depth of emotional resonance, evoked through careful study of light and texture. The juxtaposition of simplicity with complexity will hopefully create a lasting impact on those who would like to engage with the work."
