Leader was born in Worcester where he studied at the Worcester School of Design before going on to the Royal Academy Schools in London. Much of his subject matter was taken from the area around his native Worcestershire or nearby Wales. In 1863 his work *The Churchyard at Bettwys-y-Coed* was purchased by the Prime Minister, William Gladstone. He became one of Britain's most prominent and successful landscape painters and a frequent exhibitor at the Royal Academy and elsewhere. He is represented in many public collections.
